The Wilmette Public Schools District 39 Board of Education has begun the search process for a new superintendent who will begin duties on July 1, 2019. The Board of Education would like to take this opportunity to thank Dr. Ray Lechner for his efforts over the past 20 years.

The Board has selected **SCHOOL EXEC CONNECT**, an educational search firm, to assist us in the superintendent search. The first step in this process is to create a New Superintendent Profile, using information gathered from focus groups and from an on-line survey. The New Superintendent Profile will guide us in the selection process.

A Stakeholder/Confidential Committee will be established to interview the final two or three candidates and share their feedback with the Board of Education. We plan that those involved in the search will hold candidate names confidential throughout the process.
