## 2024 Summer Enrichment Program (SEP) Transportation Options

## For Students Living Within the Wilmette Public Schools District 39 Boundaries:

Bus service to and from Romona Elementary and Highcrest Middle School will be offered to students for a flat fee of \$175.

- Transportation is only offered *before* period 1 and *after* period 3. Transportation will not run between periods.
- No additional stops will be added to the bus routes after May 3rd. Students
  registering after this date will be placed on an existing route. If we do not have a
  scheduled stop to accommodate your student, we will refund your transportation fee.
- The schedule and routes will be communicated to families approximately one week before the start of our summer programs.

## **Other Transportation Options:**

District 39 will also offer transportation <u>after third period classes</u> from Romona & Highcrest to the *Wilmette Park District camps* listed below:

- → For students who live <u>within</u> the District 39 boundaries, this service is included in the \$175 transportation fee
- → For students who live <u>outside</u> the District 39 boundaries, this transportation can be purchased for \$175

At the end of third period, buses will transport students who registered for this service from their SEP location *to one of the following Wilmette Park District camps:* 

- Afternoon Adventures Camp at Romona Elementary
- Arts in the Park Camp at the Community Rec Center
- Junior Day Camp at Highcrest Middle School
- Great Gillson Camp at Gillson Park
- Sports Camp at Highcrest Middle School
